CONVENTIONS

Upon review of the HCC finances, the Board is happy to announce that registered member "dancers" who attend a convention in 2021 will receive reimbursement for a one-time registration fee. Reimbursements will be distributed AFTER attending a convention.

In order to be eligible to receive reimbursement, a dancer must:

- 1) Register as a Hill Country Clogger
- 2) Participate in at least one class
- 3) Provide our treasurer (Tom Poole) with a copy of the registration form and proof of payment no later than 14 days after the convention.
