STIPENDS FOR CONVENTIONS

Even though the advent of COVID resulted in significantly fewer demos, and ultimately less income for the Hill Country Cloggers, the Board has agreed to continue to support members who attend conventions in 2022.

Member dancers will receive a one-time \$50.00 stipend and member non-dancers/spectators will receive a one-time reimbursement for their entry fee. Reimbursements will be distributed AFTER attending a convention. Stipend or reimbursements will be provided for one convention per member per calendar year.

Eligibility to receive a stipend is contingent upon:

1) Registering as a Hill Country Clogger (HCC) and performing or attending as a representative of HCC.

2) Participating in at least one class (if a dancer).

3) Providing our treasurer (Tom Poole) with a copy of the registration form and proof of payment **no later than 14 days** after the convention.
